Discussion Questions:

1.	leadership engagement with their efforts (Stepping Up or diversion generally) and any barriers to such engagement.
2.	Do we conduct timely screening and assessment? Discussion about the importance of universal screening of everyone who is booked into jail using a validated tool for mental health needs (this is not the same as suicide risk), and a definition of Serious Mental Illness that is shared between jail and county behavioral health staff.



3.	 Do we have baseline data? Discussion about what it would take to have accurate data about: Jail Admissions – the number of people with mental illnesses who are booked into jail Their average length of stay in jail
	 Percentage of people with mental illnesses who are connected to treatment following release Their recidivism rate
4.	Have we prioritized policy, practice, and funding improvements? This will lead into tomorrow's conversation.
5.	What have you heard in today's discussion that you can see transforming into a deed when you get home?
