The Be Well Orange Campus delivers coordinated behavioral health services to all Orange County residents, regardless of payor, which included the first ever sobering station in OC a Crisis Stabilization Unit for adults and youth, Withdrawal Management, Crisis Residential Program (CRP) and Substance Use Disorder and Co-Occurring Residential.

These campuses are also open to law enforcement as an alternative to arrest, to divert individuals in a behavioral health crisis towards treatment. The first Be Well Orange County campus opened in January 2021 and the demand for integrated behavioral health services has prompted the development of a second campus.






# Services Offered

- **Sobering Station** provides a safe place for persons who are experiencing intoxication and includes monitoring and referrals to follow up services for SUD disorders.
- Residential Services a non-institutionalized, 24 hour, short term residential that provides rehabilitation services.
- **Co-Occurring Services** treat individuals with both mental health and substance use disorder needs.
- Withdrawal Management Services provides detoxification services. Services include monitoring, counseling and referral to treatment and other services.
- Crisis Residential Program provides positive, temporary alternatives for people experiencing acute psychiatric episodes or intense emotional distress who might otherwise face voluntary or involuntary inpatient Treatment.
- Adolescent and Adult Crisis Stabilization Unit Services provides 24/7 psychiatric crisis stabilization services for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis

## How is Be Well Doing?

- Adult CSU received 724 referrals from Law Enforcement in FY 21-22
- Adolescent CSU received 73 referrals from LE in FY 21-22
- 4,671 total served in FY 21-22
