

What does Santa Cruz Probation Pretrial Do?

Pretrial as an alternative to custody

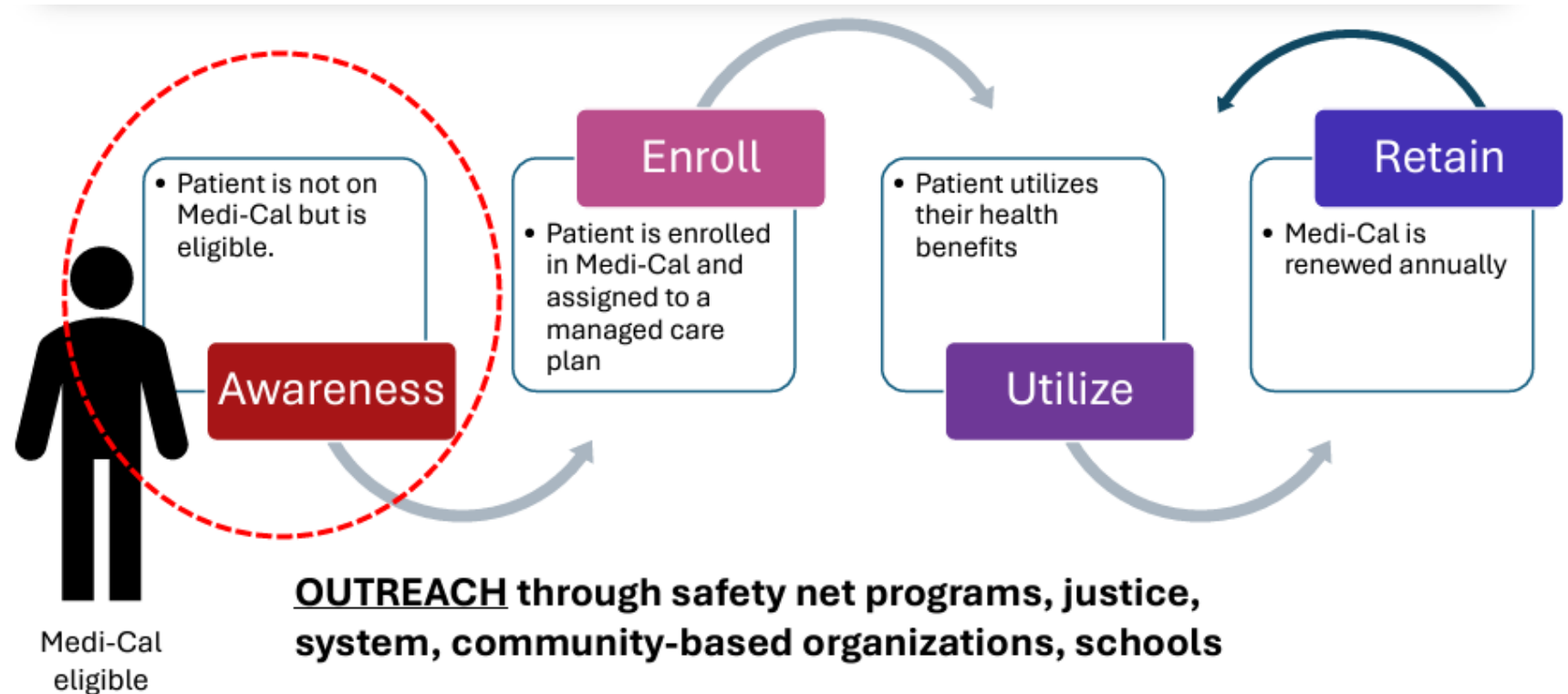
- Provides Reports to Court on Pretrial Risk of:
 - A new crime while pending court
 - Not showing up for court
 - Risk of Violence while pending court
- Monitoring in the community for people granted Supervised Own Release or Electronic Monitoring

Pretrial as a Connector

- *Leverage* funding sources and local grants to provide voluntary and court ordered services to support individuals during their pretrial program.
- Bridge Housing
- Treatment (MH & SUD)
- Cell Phone
- Clothing and Hygiene Supplies
- Success Center: Classes, Education, Computer Lab, Parenting, Employment and related services
- Connect individuals to other voluntary programs and resources.
- Cal-AIM Medi-Cal screening and connections to apply
- Referrals to Community Based Providers
- Linkages to other county departments for eligibility, benefits and services

Santa Cruz County Probation Pretrial Program

- Santa Cruz Pretrial is an active part of working to connect people to Health Insurance as part of CalAIM JI



Defining what pretrial success means in Santa Cruz County

BEFORE

59%

Pretrial Success Rate

*Percentage of cases where the individual completes pretrial supervision **without a new arrest** and **without a failure to appear** and **without any technical violations***

AFTER

80%

Pretrial Success Rate

*Percentage of cases where the individual completes pretrial supervision **without a new arrest** and **without a failure to appear***

Supervision Success Rate

*Percentage of cases where the individual completes pretrial supervision **without any technical violations***

The new distinction allows pretrial to track their success against their core goals (maintaining safety and court appearances). Additionally, by tracking supervision success the agency can attempt to support individuals struggling with pretrial mandates and at risk of revocation.
