Direct crisis hotline connection: every screen in the app has a "Get Help Now" button for quick access to the crisis hotline or 911

Signs & Symptoms: information about nine prevalent mental disorders, including a section titled "Should I Be Worried?"

Resource Center: an interactive directory of 24 local, regional, and national agencies and organizations that can help

Did You Know: a collection to inform and encourage, including:

Famous People: bios of 10 historic figures with diagnosable mental illness

Stigma Busters: three myths debunked

Mental Illness in Movies: reviews of 10 movies that explore aspects of mental disorders (i.e. Benny & Joon, A Beautiful Mind...)
